*Poppy Hills has a slow play procedure. Marshals have the right to have players pick up their ball and move up to the group in front of you if you fall behind. If a group in our tournament suffers this fate, every member of that group will be Disqualified from the tournament for violating Rule 11-4b.*

*It is every competitor's responsibility to avoid this situation. There are no grounds for appeal to the Committee if a group must skip a hole.*

**EACH FOURSOME: Please record your group's actual starting time and completion time (use time on Cart's GPS display).**

### **Conditions of Competition**

1. The tournament format is individual net medal play.
2. Play from the White tees.
3. USGA rules apply. Also see the Local Rules on the scorecard.
4. In the event of a rules dispute that cannot be resolved on the golf course, play two balls, keep both scores, and obtain a ruling after the round from the pro-shop and/or tournament official (*RULE 3-3, Doubt As To Procedure*).
5. Where necessary, ties will be broken for the first and last pay off spot according to the USGA recommendation on how to settle ties by scorecard (Appendix 1, Conditions of the Competition - How to Decide Ties). If this does not determine a winner, we will apply this procedure to the front nine.

### **Tournament Procedure**

6. Exchange your scorecard with another member of your group. **Record the Start and End Times** on the scorecard.
7. When you are finished playing, turn in your **SIGNED** and **COMPLETED** score cards to the tournament chairman at the scorer's table in the restaurant. Please check your card before signing for accuracy of your scores. Scorer signs the card and the Competitor must attest his score.
8. **Do not** post scores on the computer after the round. Your "T" score will be posted for you.

### **Tournament Issues**

9. Through the green, a ball that comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green. On the putting green, a ball that comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be placed at the nearest spot not nearer the hole that avoids the situation.
