## Minhoto Scores Hole-In-One

Past president Manuel A. Minhoto scored a hole-in-one at the Dublin Ranch Golf Course, in Dublin, Ca. It was during the Dublin Chamber of Commerce Annual Fund Raising Golf Tournament held on May 9th. Manuel hit a 9 iron to the elevated green on the 120 yard 6th hole. He and the other members of the foursome did not see the ball after it cleared the top of the hill, so it was a huge, unexpected surprise when they found his ball in the hole. Manuel won a package of Sony gifts. It was his first hole-in-one.

## New Local Rule

A new local rule was defined and implemented prior to the May 15th tournament. Its purpose is to clarify a situation which occurred during the April tournament when a white out of bound stake for hole 2 interfered with the swing of a player on hole 1. An OB stake cannot be moved and relief is normally not allowed. However, as the new rule states, "Interior OB stakes down the right side of hole #1 and down the left side of hole #9 are considered Immovable Obstructions and free relief may be taken."

Match Play for the remaining 3 rounds. Quarter-final matches are played on Sunday Aug 14th; Semi-final matches played on Saturday Aug 20st; Final-round matches are played on Sunday Aug 21st.

The Handicapped Flights play from the Crimson tees, at full handicap.

The Championship Flight plays from the Black tees, at scratch.

### Championship Flight policy:

- \* Limited to those who have played in a minimum of three STMGC tournaments during FY2005.
- \* If fewer than 8 players sign-up: There won't be a Championship (Scratch) flight.
- \* If 8 players sign-up: The 4 lowest indexes are seeded in order; the 4 highest indexes are seeded randomly. Matches are played on 8/13, 8/14, and 8/21.
- \* If more than 8 players sign-up: Round 1 is a qualifying round, conducted at Stroke Play, to determine the 8 seedings in the bracket. Match Play will be conducted for the remaining 3 rounds, per the schedule listed at the top of this entry form.

## September 2005 Qualifier for the 2006 NCGA Zone Tournament

Saturday September 17th and Sunday September 18th; starting time 11:00.

Maximum 72 players. Entry Deadline: 9/10/2005. Entry fee is \$126 per2- team.

FORMAT: Flighted, 2-man Better Ball Qualifier. The lowest one-third of each flight (to a maximum of 10 teams total) will advance to Sunday September 18th at 11 AM; payout will be based on cumulative 2-day team score. Players making the cut will be responsible for paying their greens fees directly to the ProShop on Sunday morning. The two flight winners will advance to the 2006 South Bay Regional Zone on dates TBD. Teams will compete under the following conditions (see the NCGA 2005 Blue Book for more information).

Play will be at 90% of course handicap, using a maximum index of 18.4;  
players with indexes exceeding 18.4 may still play, but they will use an index of 18.4.

If partner's course handicaps differ by more than 8 strokes,  
an additional 10% reduction will be applied to their course handicaps.

In lieu of certificates, the qualifying teams will have their entry fee paid to the South Bay Zone Championship, and, if they advance, to the NCGA Zone Championship. If either player of the qualifying team is unable to play in the South Bay Zone Championship, the 2nd place team (in their flight) will take their place at the South Bay Regional Zone and any subsequent competition.
