The President's Corner by Tim Pasek

September marks the beginning of another tournament year for STMGC. We highlight some year-end milestones:

Congratulations to the 20 men who qualified for the October 12th TOC tournament at Poppy Hills (see page 2 for final standings of the TOC competition).

Congratulations to Eric Simonsen, who won the Most Improved Golfer award; Eric's index went from 12.5 last September to 6.5 this September.

Congratulations to our newest Club Champion: Steve Massicotte, who defeated me in the finals. See page 4 for complete results.

The Board of Directors bids farewell to Rick Hilton, and thanks him for his 4 years of service on the Board; congratulations to Steve Lapointe on his election as our newest Director (see page 2 for the entire Board).

While the composition of the Board remains largely unchanged, some of the roles have been swapped: Stan Yamada is our new Tournament Director, Gib Gibson is now

our Treasurer, and Steve Ochoa is our new Vice-President.

Based on the results of the online survey in early 2005, we've made some changes to the way we run our tournaments:

1) For 1-day tournaments, we've increased our payouts by 25%; for 2-day tournaments, we've increased our payouts by 92%. A small portion of this payout increase is funded by an extra \$1 from the player; the rest comes from the Club. You'll find the correct amount mentioned on each entry form.

2) Due to lack of interest, we've discontinued the Accurate Drive and Low Gross awards.

3) For tournament rounds, there is no longer any need for you to post your adjusted score; the software we're using will upload the adjusted scores to GHIN. (Note: you're still responsible for posting your adjusted scores for your non-STMGC rounds).

4) We've decided to change the format of this year's Turkey Shoot from an Individual Low Net (ILN) to a Match Play event. You can choose your opponent on the entry form, or we'll find one for you. It's straight match-play, where the lower handicapper gives strokes on the appropriate holes to the higher handicapper. You'll find the entry form on page 7. The winner of the match gets the "turkey", which is historically a gift certificate to a local grocery store. This is a great way to start a traditional "grudge-match" against one of your buddies; the winner can have bragging rights for the whole year.

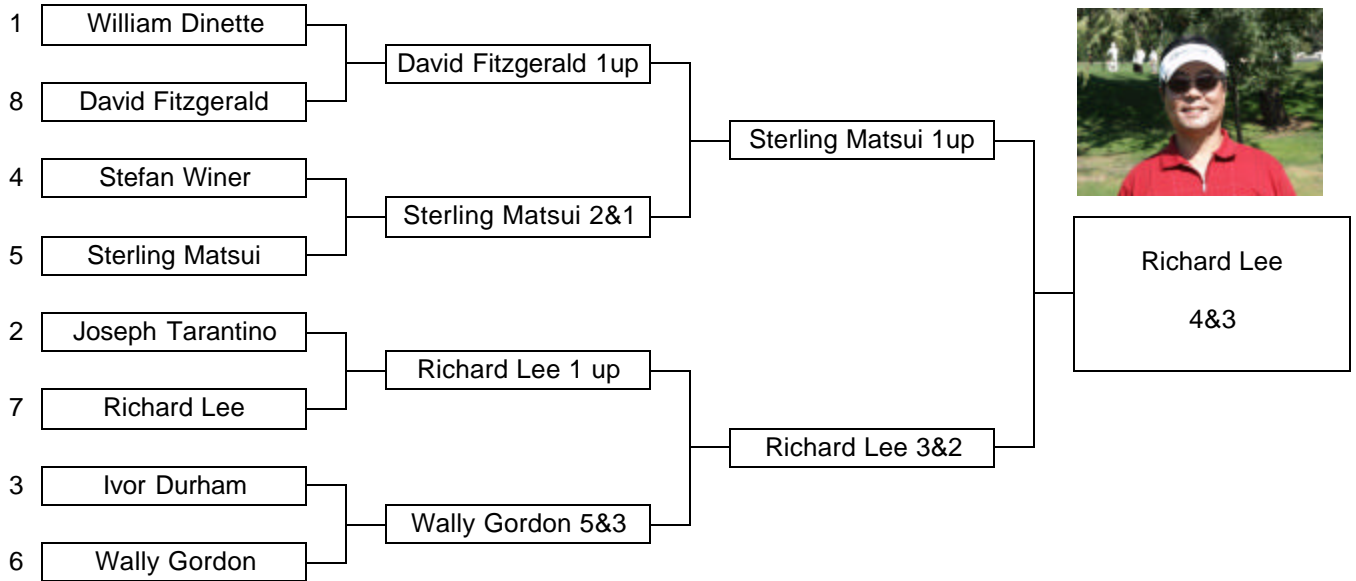
